Christian conversion is promoted by conversation

"The heart is deceitful above all others things." Jer 17:9

I recently had dealings with a woman who had made a mess of her life - seriously. I heard some of her story. How accurate was the telling, I don't know but she had some things right: she had stuffed up and it was largely her fault. How Jesus must love that honesty. When she is ready to change, the solid foundation is there.

But what about us whose lives are built around religious practice? We, in the pews, need to ask ourselves how well our own consciences have been formed and could we respond with such honesty. Or do we too suffer some form of amnesia?

It seems to me that religious practice can be a distraction from the struggle with the evil in our hearts which Jesus presents as an integral aspect of belief in God. Interestingly in the Gospel, while Jesus practised as a Jew, he was not fussed about observances. In fact, he himself offered very few practices to his disciples, for example, the Our Father as a prayer and the celebration of Eucharist about which very few clear directions actually were given.

When Jesus describes the criteria for judgment on the Last Day, theology and practice don't get a mention. But clearly in this Sunday's Gospel, we are directed to a major concern in living our faith: the state of our heart. Jesus presents a list of formidable evils lurking there. Dealing with them will force us to be honest... and truly dependent on God for our salvation. "What God is concerned with is the human heart. If that is far from God, all the religious practices in the world are only lip-service."

This is the first week-end of Spring in Queensland. Perhaps it is an opportune time for some 'spring-cleaning' in our lives. Perhaps we could ask ourselves how well have our consciences been formed? Are we living with some form of amnesia in our spiritual lives? Perhaps as we begin this wonderful season of growth and new life and do some 'spring-cleaning' we will become more honest and faith-filled people.

Mary Immaculate St Vincent de Paul Conference

Thank you, Parishioners, for your continued generous support for our work. More than \$9000 was raised for our Conference from the Winter Appeal and Bunnings BarBQ – an absolutely inspiring effort! Thank so much for continuing to give to the Poor Box and to the Food Hamper collection bins in Labrador and Ashmore churches. Your gifts of basic foods - a can of tuna, beans or tomatoes, a pack of noodles, pasta or rice - reduce our hamper costs and free up funds to give that extra "hand up" in other areas.

During June and July our Conference made 61 home visits and spent 54 hours on the road. We assisted 156 people (50% children) using \$3,817 (mostly food; some clothes, furniture and medication). For families who cannot pay their electricity bills we assist them in dealing with their supplier to access the emergency assistance, hardship and energy saver schemes. In October our members will undertake basic budgeting training so that we can help families identify "money leaks" and better manage their spending.

The recently formed St Vincent de Paul Aquinas College Conference has the full support of our Conference. The students are keen to take up social justice activities, living their faith and prayer through working hard to help those in need. They ran the school Winter Appeal resulting in several big bins of non-perishable food and large bags of warm clothes and bedding that gave warmth and nourishment to the many families in need that we visited over Winter. More projects are underway!

You are good stewards putting your faith into action through your practical support of St Vincent de Paul good works. We thank you and keep you and your families in our prayers.


