

We call this Sunday, Good Shepherd Sunday. Jesus speaks of himself as our Good Shepherd:

*"I am the Good Shepherd... The Good Shepherd lays down his life for his Sheep." (Jn 10:11.15)*

Jesus is known as the Good Shepherd because like a shepherd He knows His sheep. He cares for the flock that God gave Him.

Jesus knows well that it's difficult to follow Him. He knows our sins and weaknesses. Yes, Jesus is our protector. We can't be lost

when we follow Him. No one can take us away from Him, from His flock when we are united to Him.

Sometimes we wrongly think that we can do it by ourselves or something or someone else can care for us better than Jesus. So let us remember that He will not abandon us, instead He wants to strengthen everything good in us. He always supports and loves us with His unconditional love. He is inviting us: *"Come to me, all you who labour and are burdened and I will give you rest."* (Mt 11:28)

This weekend, we pray for all vocations in our Church.

We pray for the Pope and our Bishops to be good leaders, to speak and teach us with the compassion and guidance of the Good Shepherd. They are to open our eyes and challenge us to live the Gospel in our world.

We also pray for priests and religious to live faithfully their call to support and protect the poor and to work for Peace and Justice.

We remember those who work for the Church and liturgical and pastoral ministers in our parish. May God bless them and their families as they too lay down their lives for the sheep, often at great personal cost.
