Last week the parish office received some resources (video and a PDF pamphlet) which serve as the Archbishop's address to announce the launch of the **2018 – 2020 Safeguarding Strategy**.

The Archbishop's address highlights three "P"s

Safe PEOPLE

Church personnel are appropriately selected, screened and recruited; trained in safeguarding practices; and accept their safeguarding obligations.

Safe PRACTICES

Church personnel apply safeguarding measures when conducting and delivering all Archdiocesan activities, ministries and services.

Safe PLACES

Church personnel apply safeguards to all physical environments in which Archdiocesan activities, ministries and services are conducted.

To coincide with the launch of this new strategy, the address includes an announcement of the rebranding of the '**Safeguarding & Professional Standards Service**' to the '**Office for Safeguarding Services**'.

The functions of the new office are to:

- ◆ develop and implement safeguarding standards, policies and procedures;
- ◆ enhance capacity to achieve compliance with safeguarding standards, policies and procedures; and
- ◆ support Archdiocesan church personnel in managing safeguarding disclosures, suspicions and allegations.

Following the Sacramental Policy of Archdiocese of Brisbane the Sacrament of Confirmation is available to those children who are 8 years of age (Year 3) or older. This is the next spiritual journey that your child will engage in after their Baptism. They will be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. *(Children must be baptised Catholics).*
