



Dear Parishioners,

Fr Jan has asked me to provide an update on the progress and time line for the LCC which I thought I would do with a brief Q&A. One thing that is a looming deadline is **the need to finalise the tile dedications by Mid-August**. All the purchased tiles will sent to our stone mason for cutting by mid-August, so if you have been thinking about it PLEASE order your tile soon! **(Form inside - page 3)**

Q: Will the LCC proceed if the parish doesn't meet the fund raising target?

A: Yes. Fr Jan says that the generosity of Parishioners and the intercession of St Joseph will help to build the LCC. These two "instruments" of the **people's prayer of generosity** have always been the driving force behind different projects in the Church's life. Fr Jan says that the Southport Parish is able to support the LCC project.

Q: When will LCC start and when will it be ready?

A: We expect to appoint a building contractor in August with an expected build time of 12- 14 weeks. We are hoping to have our end of year Christmas party in the new LCC!

Q: Can I buy a tile with my company?

A: Yes, but the dedication message needs to follow the line of the others, ie a dedication to a Saint, memory of a living or deceased family member etc. It's ok to have the name of the company as the donor but no sales pitch please. If in doubt please contact terry.naug@gmail.com

Q: Can I donate a larger amount than \$1000?

A: Yes, a generous parishioner is donating \$5000, we have 4 beautiful bi-fold glass doors which can be dedicated in recognition of larger donations.

Q: Can I pay with a cheque?

A: Yes, please see your local LCC ambassador or the priest saying Mass on the day with your dedication information. Cheques should be made payable to Southport Catholic Parish.
