

# Help protect the health and safety of the community

The Archdiocese of Brisbane and its parishes are taking a broad range of actions to help curb the spread of COVID-19.

We encourage you to come in and pray privately.

Please **do not** enter this church if you have:

- returned from overseas in the last 14 days
- been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- have a fever or symptoms of a respiratory infection such as a cough, sore throat or shortness of breath.

In line with advice from public health authorities, we ask that, while visiting this church, you practice social distancing and good hand and respiratory hygiene.

Please:

- maintain a distance of 1.5 metres between people
- refrain from handshaking and hugging
- frequently clean your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or using an alcohol-based hand rub
- cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or flexed elbow when coughing or sneezing
- open windows and adjust air conditioning for more ventilation
- adhere to the strictest hygiene practices in food preparation, including limiting the handling and sharing of food.
