Dear Parishioners of the Southport Catholic Parish,

We **Thank You** for your patience as we come out of COVID-19 lockdown to be able to continue to have up to 100 people attend our Masses depending on the meterage restrictions for each of our Churches.

The communal nature of Mass has a high risk for transmission of COVID-19, we as a Parish Community must comply with social distancing requirements and all advice from Queensland Health.

For the Parish to continue to have Mass we must ALL adhere to the Queensland Government's COVID-19 Safe Plan for Parish Communities.

- **NO One** is to enter a church, parish building if feeling sick.
- **Every gathering including MASS you must record contact details of your attendance (name, phone, address and time of visit).**
- **Social Distancing** is to be maintained of **one per 4 square meters indoors, 1.5 meters** between people.
- **Hand sanitizer** must be used on entering the church and before communion at all Masses.
- Newsletters **MUST** be taken home as they can not be reused to prevent cross-contamination.
- At all Masses, the Body of Christ can only be administered in the hand.
- **The sign of Peace** should be limited to saying "Peace be with you" with a nod or bow; no hand-shaking or hand-holding should occur at the Our Father.
- Collection plates should not be passed from person to person.
- Our Holy water fonts will remain empty.
- After each gathering, the Church must be cleaned in adherence to COVID-19 requirements.

We do ask you to comply with all instructions you may receive from our staff and volunteers. Southport Catholic Parish has a zero tolerance to abuse. "THERE IS NO EXCUSE FOR ABUSE"

They will be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. **(Children must be baptised Catholics).**
