To begin the process please speak to Fr Gerard or me so we can arrange a time to meet at the Parish Office and process the necessary documents. **You can not begin any Volunteer work until you have those 2 documents back from the government departments.** We thank you for your understanding in these matters. We also wish to give thanks to our many volunteers who assist us in the smooth operation of our Parish.

Gold Coast University Hospital has now advised me that our Spiritual Care Volunteer's can return to service at the hospital. They have asked everyone who visits the hospital to use Hand Sanitiser on entry and leaving the facility. Also, we maintain social distancing of 1.5 meters. The Department of Health "*Guidelines for COVID-19 vulnerable staff*" under the current advice they are encouraging people who are at greater risk of acquiring a more serious illness with Covid-19 to continue to stay at home where possible.

SOME FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT PLACES OF WORSHIP

How many people can I have at a Wedding or Funeral?

Wedding ceremonies and Funeral can have a maximum of 100 people on the basis that occupant density is no more than one person per 2 square metres (up to a total of 50 people) for venues or spaces of 200 square metres or less; or no more than one person per 4 square metres for venues or spaces of 200 square metres or more. It is important if you are unwell, that you do not go to a wedding. A record of names and contact details of each guest must be kept for 56 days to assist in contact tracing if required.

Do children count in the limits on number of people?

Children and infants are included in the total numbers where limits are indicated.

What will happen if people don't follow the rules at places of worship and cases go up again? Restrictions are being lifted because Queenslanders are doing a great job at listening to health advice and following the rules. However, there is the potential for our state to require tougher restrictions to be enforced if people don't abide by the new restrictions.

Are there penalties if I don't comply? Yes. If you don't comply you may be given an on-the-spot fine of **\$1,334** for individuals and \$6,670 for corporations under the Public Health Act 2005.

YOUR PLACE OF WORSHIP

Please stay at home if you are sick, and to go home immediately if you become unwell. Please be tested for COVID-19 if you have any symptoms of acute respiratory disease (cough, sore throat, shortness of breath) or a fever or history of fever. Remain in isolation at home till you get a negative result for COVID-19.

For your safety and others please use the sanitizer provided before entering and leaving the church.

Personal information about individuals' is carefully kept in line with privacy laws.

Masses:

- ◆ We ask that once you are seated at Mass that you do not move to another seat.
- ◆ The Sign of Peace should be limited to saying "Peace be with you" with a nod or bow; no hand-shaking or hand-holding should occur here or at the Our Father
- ◆ Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who assist to distribute Communion must sanitise their hands before and after distributing.
- ◆ At Communion time please remember social distancing as you come forward.
- ◆ Communion should be received only in the hand.
- ◆ Collection plates should be held by the collector and not passed from person to person.
